Momo Challenge

We have been aware this week of concerns and worries about the Momo challenge that has appeared on social media.

We would like to draw your attention to the following website which gives information regarding this.

Charities, including the NSPCC, say there have been no reports of anybody being "hacked" or harming themselves as a result. The image, though, is now being shared on social media to frighten children. Unofficial copies of cartoons such as Peppa Pig have been uploaded to YouTube with footage of "momo" edited in.

Children watching unofficial uploads may therefore be exposed to the image, however, it is just a picture.

In school we have followed police advice and used this event to remind the children about internet safety and given them advice on what to do if they are worried by anything.

This includes:

Stop and tell someone if you see something that makes you feel uncomfortable or asks you to do something.

Checking to make sure that devices have the correct safety settings.

We have used guidelines from the NSPCC to reassure children that they are safe and that appropriate safety settings are in place in school on all devices.
