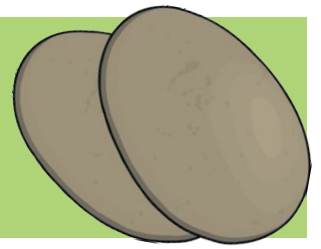


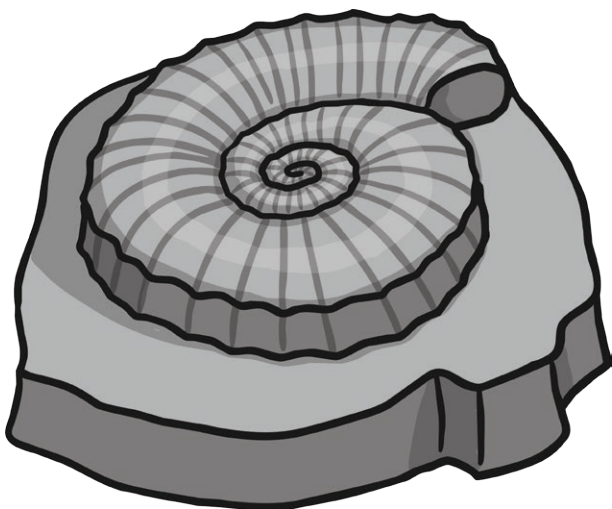
Make a Dinosaur Egg Fossil

Science Experiment



Method

1. Mix the flour, coffee grounds, salt, baking soda together as you gradually add the water until the wet mixture is able to be moulded.
2. Form the mixture into round, flat balls large enough to fit the dinosaur toys inside.
3. Press a dinosaur toy firmly into each ball then form the mixture into an egg shape around the dinosaur toy.
4. Place the balls on a cookie sheet lined with waxed paper and bake for 30 minutes.
5. Leave to cool and harden overnight.
6. Allow the children to play with the fossil eggs. Can they open the egg to find the dinosaur?



You will need:

- 50g plain flour
- 150g baking soda
- 125g used ground coffee
- 60g salt
- 100ml water (please note: not all 100ml of the water may be needed)
- Small plastic dinosaur toys
- Baking tray
- Baking paper
- Vinegar
- Pipette
- Children's hammer
- Oven set to 120°C
